






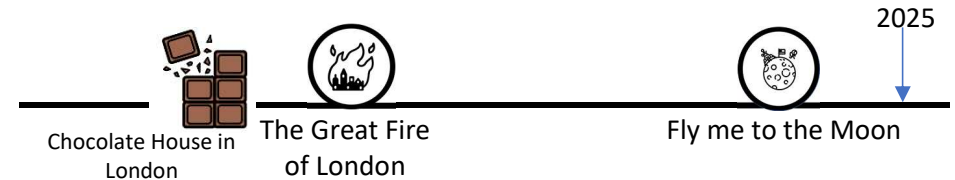
History of chocolate timeline
