- Can they spot any of the letter sounds we have been learning at school in the book title?
- Praise your child for having a go, make sure they realise how much you love to hear them read. Read the book multiple times to allow for greater understanding of the story.

Also, try to find time to read your child a bedtime story. The most important part of reading is enjoyment, developing a love of books will turn them into successful readers
