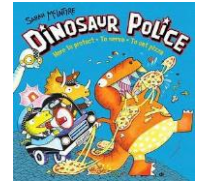
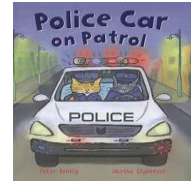
St Francis Class

Happy New Year! We hope that you all had a wonderful Christmas. It has been lovely to welcome the children back into school and we look forward to the Spring term ahead of us.

Our topic for this half term is '999, What is your Emergency?' In this topic we will focus on people who help us in our community.

In our first few weeks we are learning about the police and about the important role they have. We will be using the books 'Police Car on Patrol' by Peter Bently and 'Dinosaur Police' by Sarah McIntyre to help us with our learning



In maths we are focussing on the composition of (how to explain) numbers e.g. 5 can be made up of 0+5 / 1+4 / 2+3 etc. and comparing numbers, using the vocabulary of greater and smaller, more and fewer.

The phonics we will be learning are:-

oo, ar, ur, oo, or

We are learning that two letters that make one sound are called '**digraphs**'. We are also learning that three letters that make one sound are called '**trigraphs**'.

We are working on writing the letters correctly and using them in our reading and writing.

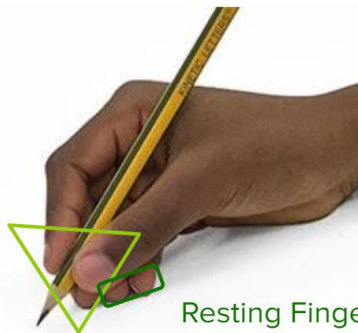
