We are all very much enjoying our topic of 'Beside the Seaside.'

For the next few weeks we are focussing on sea poetry. We will be reading a range of poems about the sea and sea creatures. We will then be writing our own poem.

We are also going to be looking in detail at boats. The book that will help us with our learning is 'Mr Gumpy's Outing.' We will be exploring materials to find out about floating and sinking and then designing and making our own boats, like Mr Gumpy's boat.

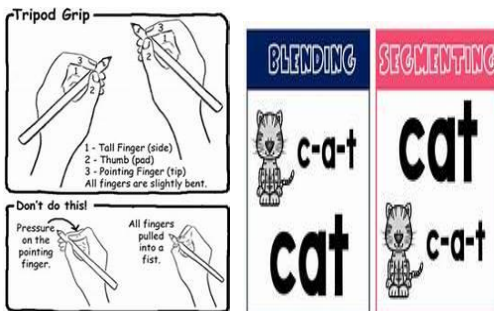


The phonics we will be learning are:-

wh, ph, ew, oe, au, ey, ae, ee

We are learning that two letters that make one sound are called '**digraphs**'. We are also learning that three letters that make one sound are called '**trigraphs**'. We are learning about '**split digraphs**' like **a_e** in words such as b-a-k-e.

We are working on using our letter sound knowledge independently in our reading and writing.

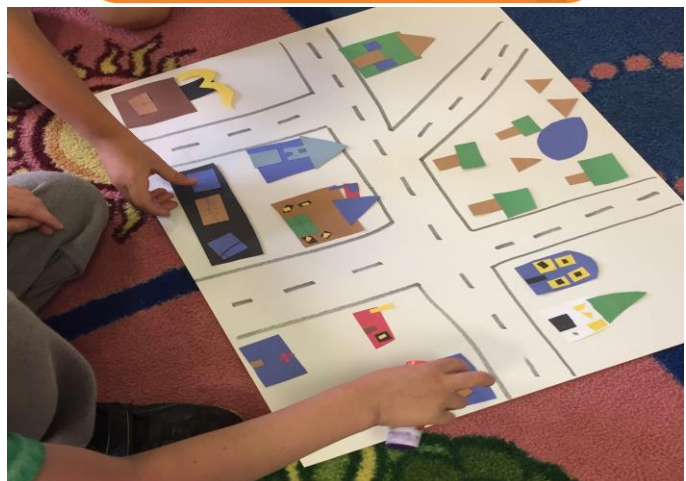
Maths:
