
This week we are focussing on Magic Shows. We are learning how to perform our own magic shows and we are experimenting making magical potions! The book that will help us with our learning this week is 'Bad Bunnies Magic Show'.



This half term we are reviewing all of the letter sounds that we have learnt so far.

We are developing our ability to read ccvcc words (consonant-consonant-consonant) i.e. trunk, frost and cccvc words i.e. split, scrap (consonant-consonant-consonant-vowel-consonant).

We are working on writing the letters correctly and using them in our reading and writing with growing independence.


