## Communication and Language:

- We will name the Emergency Services and say how they help our community.
- We will ask questions to find out more information about the Emergency Services.

## Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

- We will be learning about who is in our families and how to be a good friend.
- This will include exploring the wonder of being 'unique and special' and how we are special to our family and to God.

## Physical Development:

- We will be having PE lessons in the hall. We will be working with others by negotiating space, taking turns and sharing the PE resources.
- We will be developing our gross motor skills (building and balancing with large blocks) and our fine motor skills (threading, using playdough etc). We will be ensuring that we write our letters with a 'lead in and a lead out'.

## Literacy:

- We will write sentences about what we have learnt about the Emergency Services.
- We will write a description of a Police Officer.
- We will write a recount about our local walk.



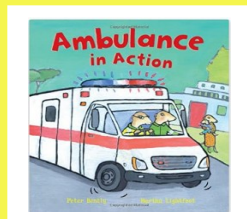
## Maths:

In our Maths for this half term:

- We will be exploring 0, comparing numbers to 8 and thinking about the composition of numbers. We will also be comparing mass and capacity.
- We will be finding out about the numbers 6, 7 and 8. We will also be making pairs and learning how to combine two groups of numbers. Additionally, we will be exploring length/height and time.

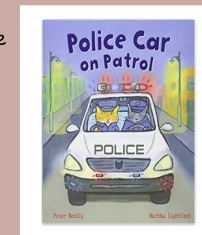
## Understanding of the World:
